Snow Day Online Learning for North Elementary

Snow days this year will be online learning days. This way they can count as regular days and we will not need to add days to the end of the year. Grade level teachers have gotten together to plan for these snow days just in case the district needs to call them. The following are the plans teachers have made for these snow days. Please follow these plans if a snow day is called.

Kindergarten: Teachers will be sending home a Readers Notebook for students to leave in their backpack or keep at home in case of a snow day. If a snow day is called teachers will contact parents to let them know what pages should be done. They will ask students to work on their flashcards and will also communicate an enrichment activity to complete. If Chromebooks are home, teachers will also communicate a link to do a Google Meet with students at 9 AM.

1st Grade: Teachers will be placing a Snow Day packet in student backpacks. Please keep them for when a snow day is called. Teachers will also hold a Google Meet at 10 AM for all who can get on. The link for the Google Meet will be posted on Canvas. If a bad storm is expected teachers will send Chromebooks home, just in case. If questions arise, teachers will be available on Class Tag.

 2^{nd} Grade: Teachers will meet with students on Google Meets at 9 AM and assignments will be given on Reading A-Z, Istation Math/Reading, Spelling City, Journeys, Prodigy, DMTI Fluency App, and/or Imagine Math Facts. The link for the Google Meet will be posted on Canvas.

3rd Grade: Please see "ICON" button labeled 'SNOW DAY' in Canvas to click on. This will direct students/parents to directions, activities, and worksheets. Parents/students who have prearranged a need for worksheets will have a folder labeled Snow Day in their backpacks for these days only. Teachers will also hold a Google Meet at 9 AM for all who can get on. The link for the Google Meet will be posted on Canvas.

 4^{th} Grade: Snow Day Packets should be found in student backpacks. Please only complete if a snow day is called. Teachers will also hold a Google Meet at 9 AM for all who can get on. The link for the Google Meet will be posted on Canvas.

Resource Room: Snow Day Folders should be found in student backpacks. Please only complete if a snow day is called. Teacher and para will also hold a Google Meet at 9 AM for all who can get on. The link for the Google Meet will be emailed and posted on Mrs. McCullough's Canvas Page.

Structured Learning Center and Extended Resource Room teachers and paras will start making calls to parents and students at approximately 9 AM. At that time they will share any plans for learning.
