Weather

Winter Weather is always a time of wonder, fun, and excitement for children. It is also a time of worry for any adults that supervise children.

Be sure to check the weather, radio, and T.V. for school late starts and closure information. Blackboard messages will also be sent.

Please discuss and/or remind your children that as they are walking to school to be cautious. They need to make sure they give cars extra time to stop before crossing the roads on crosswalks and to walk on the sidewalk further from the road just in case they start sliding out of control.

We have students who are crossing the road in front of the school without walking to the crosswalks. This is dangerous and even more dangerous when the roads are icy and snow covered. When you drop your students off for school or when they walk to school please ask them to cross the roads at the crosswalks so that we can help keep them safe.

Students are outside before school, at lunch recess, and afternoon recess if the weather permits. They need to remember to dress for the weather. Coats, hats, gloves, scarves, snow pants and snow

boots can keep the students warm on chilly days.

Please remember it is unsafe to drive through the parking lot when the parking lot is blocked. Please do not drive through the empty parking spots.

Also remind your children the school rule dealing with snow and ice: Snow needs to stay on the ground and students are not to be sliding on any ice. It is miserable for students to spend the rest of the day at school cold, wet, and sore.

Absences

If your child is absent from school, please call the school to inform us of the absence. If you are unable to call the school the day of the absence, you can send a note with your child when they return or call when you can. Unverified absences result in unexcused absences. Many students were absent before Christmas Break and these absences need to be excused. Our office number is 208-587-2585.
