Please put names on items so they can be returned to students if misplaced.

North's office staff will use the following guidelines when determining whether or not to curtail or cancel outside activity during inclement weather. When the temperature and wind chill are:

10 degrees or higher	Outside activities continue as normal
9 – 0 degrees	Outside activity may be limited or shortened
0 degrees & below	Outside activity will be curtailed or canceled

If your child wears boots and has PE on Thursday or Friday please remind them to bring gym shoes for PE.
